The name of Fort Custer derives from the name of General George Armstrong Custer, a native of the state of Michigan. The original Custer field was built in 1917 on 130 plots of land, mostly small farms rented in the government by the local trade chamber as part of the military mobilization for the First World War. After a two-year grace, the army could buy it for around \$ 98 acre. The construction of the field began in July 1917 and within five months 2,000 buildings were ready to accommodate about 36,900 men. During the First World War, about 90,000 soldiers passed for Camp Custer. After the 1918 armistice, the field became a demobilization base for over 100,000 men. Some troops have passed by here twice, going to war and returning home. On 10 May 1923, an executive decree transferred 675 acres to the Veterans Bureau, the predecessor organization of the Veterans Administration, for the construction Battle Creek Veterans Hospital, which was completed in 1924. Once, the IL and patients from the hospital cultivated about 200 acres of the site. It was considered a good therapy for patients and helped the hospital to be reasonably self-sufficient. During these early years, many pine trees were planted in the north-eastern corner of the cemetery, which today presents an attractive feature similar to the cathedral. The establishment of Fort Custer Post Cemetery took place on 18 September 1943, with the first interment. Under the rules of the army, the officers and men enlisted were segregated, even after death. As a result, Section A of the postal cemetery is full of serviemen enlisted, while Section O was reserved to officers. During World War II, the fort was expanded to more than 14,000 acres. In addition to its use as a base of formation, more than 5,000 German prisoners of war were held. Finding an experienced agricultural labor during the war became a problem as more Americans were drafted in the military or worked in factories producing war materials. Putting Fort Custer prisoners to work seemed an efficient solution to the shortage of work. The last German prisoners returned to their homeland and left Fort Custer in 1946. They left 26 fellows buried in the old cemetery post. Sixteen of the German prisoners were killed in an accident when their truck collided with a train as they returned to the fort by a detail of the work on a sugar beet farm near Blissfield, Mich. The other 10 died of natural causes. The Germans sent there for detention were retrained for jobs and shipped to other U.S. installations as duty workers. Already in the 1960s, local politicians and veteran organizations support the establishment of a national cemetery in Fort Custer. The 1973 national cemeteries act, signed by President Richard Nixon, transferred cemeteries from the Army Department to what became the National Cemetery System (NCS), the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). In addition, the law directed VA to develop a plan to provide burial space for all veterans who wanted to interact in a national cemetery. After many studies, the NCS adopted what became the regional concept. He ordered the designation or construction of a large national cemetery in each of the 10 standard federal regions. A policy was also established that the new cemeteries would be created only on the land already owned by the federal government. The Fort Custer site, located halfway between Chicago and Detroit, was the choice of VA for the national V region of the national cemetery. To this end, Congress created the National Cemetery of Fort Custer in September 1981. The cemetery received 566 acres from the military reserve of Fort Custer and 203from the VA Medical Center. The first burial took place on June 1, 1982. At the same time, about 2,600 graveyards were available in the Post Cemetery, which allowed veterans to be buried there while the new structure was developed. On Memorial Day 1982, more than 33 years after the first resolution was introduced in Congress, impressively impressive marked the official opening of the cemetery. Extension of the cemetery, Phase II Gravesite Expansion and Development, began in June 1997 and was completed in October 1998. These additional 60 hectares will provide 10,000 additional tombs and roads. Monuments and memorialsFort Custer features a memorial trail flanked by a series of memorials honoring Americaâs veterans, donated by various organizations. As of 2007, Fort Custer National Cemetery housed 31 memorials, most of which commemorated military organizations and veteran groups. The Memorial Carillon was dedicated on September 22, 1985, donated by the American Veterans Service Organization (AMVETS). In addition to the main carillon, each committal shelter is equipped with a carillon system that allows the cemetery to play songs and tapes for functions. The carillon is part of the international AMVETS carillon program to provide living commemorations in honor of American veterans. The commemorative project of the Avenue of Flags, a Fort Custer Advisory Committee company, was dedicated on May 26, 1986. The project was funded by private contributions received from private individuals and veteran service organizations. Flags Avenue is made up of 152 poles located along the main road, and another 50 poles arranged in a semicircle at the beginning of the road. Flags Avenue is displayed from Easter to Veterans Day every year, weather permitting. The 50 flags, representing each state, are waved on special occasions such as Remembrance Day.
